The Reimagining Conversation Groups identified that our parish community needs to better understand other communities – specifically racialized communities. To enact the motion at Vestry in February 2021 to address issues of anti-Black racism and bias at Holy Trinity and in the wider community, we need to learn – unlearn – together.

To help us all better understand the complex history of Canada's racialized communities, Brother Reg Crenshaw is leading a series of film and conversations. All sessions run from 6:30 – 8:00pm at this Zoom link: https://bit.ly/3A7OdWW
